Reference: Wedding Ceremonies & Blessings at Butler House

Thank you for your enquiry regarding wedding ceremonies/blessings at Butler House. Here at Butler House you have a choice of three magnificent rooms, with plasterwork ceilings, and large bow windows overlooking our Georgian walled garden and Kilkenny Castle.

The largest of the rooms will accommodate up to 90 people for a ceremony and each of the smaller rooms will accommodate up to 30/40 people.

If you are planning to get married at Butler House, we would be delighted to check available dates for you. If you are planning a civil union you must then contact the Kilkenny County Registrar, Lacken, Dublin Road, Kilkenny, to have her approve your date and Butler House as your venue. The rate charged by Butler House is €250.00 for up to 40 guests & €300 for more than 40 guests.

Rates include:

- the use of a room of your choice for the ceremony
- the use of a second room for the bridal party for a period of 1 hour prior to the ceremony & afterwards for photographs
- the exclusive use of the garden for photographs
- the use of the foyer & garden for a drinks reception (if required)

The rate does not include the registrar/celebrant fees or any other related fees. White chair covers are available & the hire charge is subject to the number of covers required. Flowers and music are not provided, but can be arranged if required. Couples are very welcome to arrange their own flowers, candles and music.

We can provide morning coffee or afternoon tea for guests on arrival, post ceremony receptions and accommodation, if required. Please find attached some information on the services we provide for these occasions. However, please note that we do not cater for full wedding receptions.
